

Itinerary-Suggestion for a daytrip in TWO countries.





Program.

9:30 am

Visit of the Salt Mine Berchtesgaden (Germany – Bavaria) for about one and a half hours: Go on a journey by a little train 650 m deep into the mountain, 2 wooden slides and an exciting boat trip through the over 500 years old Salt Mine Berchtesgaden.

The Salt Mine is easily accessible, you won't have any waiting times with a reservation and you will get an audio guide which we offer 17 different languages for free.

About 11:30 am

You will be back in Salzburg (Austria) for lunch in one of the typical restaurants to taste good Austrian food. In the afternoon you have the choice of visiting the historic city center by foot using the popular Salzburg Card for free entrance to all sights and attractions, including Mozart's birthplace, public transport or you can take the Sound of Music Tour, starting at 2:00 pm, which brings you to the lovely Salzkammergut lake area (lasts 4 h).

Experience the extraordinary in the fantastic Salt Mine tour.

Since opening in 1517, it remains a unique chronicle of 500 years of uniterrupted salt mining. Pure Alpine brine is still extracted in the salt mine today. Our visitors become immersed in the world of "white gold" and experience the amazing atmosphere of mining in the depths of the Alps. The mine's railway, separated from the mining area by only a rock face, takes you 650m deep into the mountain, where you'll find the cavernous Salt Cathedral and spectacular Miner's Slide.

Salt Mine & Eagle's Nest

An impressive trip up to the Obersalzberg to the historical view point, the Eagle's nest, combined with a guided tour through the depths of the mountain in the Salt Mine Berchtesgaden.

Time required: full day

EUR 50.00 per Adult EUR 24.90 per Child (4 – 16 years of age)



Salt Mine, Weißwurst snack & Lake Königssee

The ticket with the Lake Königssee combined a guided tour through the Salt Mine in Berchtesgaden followed by a **Weißwurst snack** and a boat drive over the emerald-green Lake Königssee in the middle of the Berchtesgaden Alpine National Park.

Time required: full day EUR 49.10 per Adult



Salt Mine & Jenner cable car

The ticket combines a guided tour through the Salt Mine in Berchtesgaden with a cable car ride in the new Jenner cable car up to the mountain summit 1.874 m. Enjoy a wonderful panoramic view of the Berchtesgaden Alps – including the Watzmann and the Lake Königssee from above.

Time required: half a day

Salt Mine & Christmas Market in Berchtesgaden

Combines an exciting underground tour through the Salt Mine in Berchtesgaden and a visit to the traditional Christmas Market in Berchtesgaden with **a glass of mulled wine**.
